What is EPS?

With Electronic Prescription Service (EPS), prescribers can send prescriptions to dispensers such as pharmacies electronically, and patients can pick up their medications directly from their closest pharmacy. Unlike paper prescriptions, electronic prescriptions can't get lost between the doctor and the pharmacy.

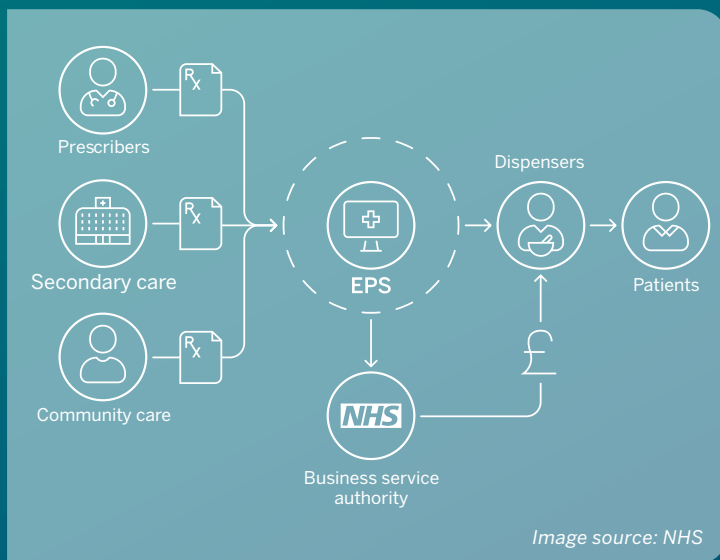

Dispensers can reduce paper usage, improve stock control, and provide more efficient service to patients with less risk of dispensing errors.

Patients can collect repeat prescriptions from their local pharmacy without visiting their GP, which saves them time and improves their experience in the healthcare system.

In collaboration with the NHS, Better has developed EPS for secondary care and outpatient prescriptions for community pharmacies.

The integration between Better Meds ePMA and EPS is based on EPS FHIR API. Before creating electronic outpatient prescriptions, users will have to compare the locally stored patient data with those stored in the Patient Demographics Service. After ensuring that an electronic prescription is being created for the right patient, processes continue to generate one or multiple prescriptions that will be sent either to the patient's nominated pharmacy or another selected pharmacy.



The vision is for Electronic Prescription Service (EPS) to be available for use by all prescribers for all prescriptions in all care settings, with the priority being increased adoption in secondary care settings.

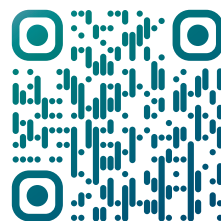
